



AGAVE CELSII

Agave celsii, a native of Mexico, forms individual rosettes to 2 feet tall and wide. The leaves are very fleshy and can range from bright green to blue-gray. It produces offsets and can form extensive colonies. This agave needs partial shade in the low deserts, but can handle full sun in cooler climates. Agave celsii is an excellent choice for shady areas. It is frost tender and will benefit from overhead frost protection. Cold hardiness information is limited, although it has reportedly tolerated temperatures as low as 12° F in Texas.
