



AGAVE SALMIANA SSP. FEROX

This large agave species develops an urn-shaped rosette of immense green leaves that curve inward. The individual leaves are about a foot wide and three feet long, with very heavy brown teeth and terminal spine. This plant needs plenty of room to grow, so space accordingly. It should also be placed away from high traffic areas, as its terminal spines are very sharp. Plant in full sun to part shade. The tall, branching flower stalk produces clusters of yellow flowers. As with most agaves, this plant dies after flowering. This variety has long been grown in European gardens. It is hardy to 15° F. USDA Zone 8.
