



## ALOE CAMPERI

This colony-forming aloe consists of individual plants growing to about 2 feet tall and wide. Each plant produces abundant offsets known as pups. The light green arching leaves are fairly narrow, with a row of teeth on each margin. Tubular orange-yellow flowers are formed on branched stalks early in the spring. *Aloe camperi* will tolerate full sun but prefers afternoon shade. It is also considered quite drought tolerant. Hardy to 28 °F. USDA Zone 9.
