



## ALOE SINKATANA

This African native forms clumping, 2 foot tall by 3 foot wide rosettes of fleshy blue-green leaves edged with marginal spines. Yellow flowers tinged with red are produced in late winter attracting hummingbirds. This aloe should be watered sparingly in the winter but provided some summer irrigation. It prefers good drainage and protection from the afternoon sun. Hardy to 25° F. USDA Zone 9.
