



ANEMOPSIS CALIFORNICA YERBA DE MANSA

This durable perennial grows aggressively to about 12 inches tall by 2-3 feet wide, forming thick stands that crowd out other plants. It thrives in wet or aquatic soils, but can exist in other soils if ample irrigation is available. White coneflowers appear in spring and summer. The large dark green leaves are extremely aromatic. Large fleshy roots and aboveground stems combine to make this plant very long-lived. Yerba Mansa will grow in sun or shade as long as adequate moisture is available. It's a terrific groundcover to plant under trees. Cut back or mow plants once a year, following any browning experienced during the winter months. It will re-sprout quickly in the spring. Hardy to -20° F, USDA Zone 5.
