



COURSETIA GLANDULOSA BABY BONNETS

This deciduous shrub is native to southern Arizona and into Mexico, growing at low elevations. Coursetia gets the common name of 'Baby Bonnets' from the multiple pea-shaped flowers that occur in shades of white, yellow, and pink. The flowers are followed by curly, thick bean-like pods. They are about 2 inches long and constricted between seeds. The tiny compound leaves emerge with the flowers in the spring. Mature plants may attain a size of 8 feet by 12 feet. Plant in full sun and well drained soils. Hardy to 20°F.
