



CUPRESSUS ARIZONICA 'COMPACTA' COMPACT ARIZONA CYPRESS

Arizona cypress is native to the higher elevations of central Arizona. It performs well in hot, interior climates, and is cold hardy to -10° F. This evergreen tree is slightly smaller than the species, topping out at a mature size of 30 feet. The foliage can vary from blue-green to silver, and is a nice contrast to the reddish-brown bark. Arizona cypress has inconspicuous green flowers, followed by rounded reddish-brown cones approximately 1 inch in diameter. For many years this tree has been a favorite windbreak in high desert grasslands. It also is useful in erosion control. Plant Arizona cypress in full sun and well-drained soil, and provide deep, infrequent summer irrigations.
