



EPILOBIUM CANUM LATIFOLIUM 'CATALINA' CATALINA FUCHSIA

Catalina fuchsia is a perennial sub-shrub native to California. The silver-gray foliage of this selection makes a striking contrast to the orange-red flowers produced in late summer and early fall. The flowers are irresistible to humming-birds. This herbaceous plant grows to 3' tall by 5' wide. Thankfully, this cultivar is more resistant to breakage than the species. It may be planted in full sun in milder areas, but appreciates some shade in lower desert regions. It is quite tolerant of drought, heat and wind once established. Hardy to 20° F. USDA Zone 9.
