



EREMOPHILA LAANII 'PINK BEAUTY'

This evergreen shrub from Australia is best suited for wide, open spaces, where it can reach its mature size without pruning or pooding. The natural form of 'Pink Beauty' is quite unique, with wild, arching branches, forming a dense shrub to about 6-8 feet tall and wide. It has been used very effectively in golf course plantings at 8 feet on center. The green foliage is reminiscent of *Myoporum parvifolium*, with narrow, bright green leaves set closely along the arching branches. In the spring, it blooms with masses of pink tubular flowers. Where you have the space, this shrub can provide a lush and distinctive look. It is hardy to 25° F. USDA Zone 9.
