



EUCALYPTUS SARGENTII SALT RIVER MALLET

This extremely salt-tolerant tree can grow to 30-40 feet tall and wide under cultivation. This Australian native is common to areas near streams and ponds that are high in salt content. It has been used commercially as a windbreak in salty soils. This attractive tree has narrow, somewhat glossy, grey-green leaves and smooth brown branches. The dark grey bark exfoliates in strips from the trunk. The flowers are pale yellow to white. It is hardy to 20° F. USDA Zone 9.
