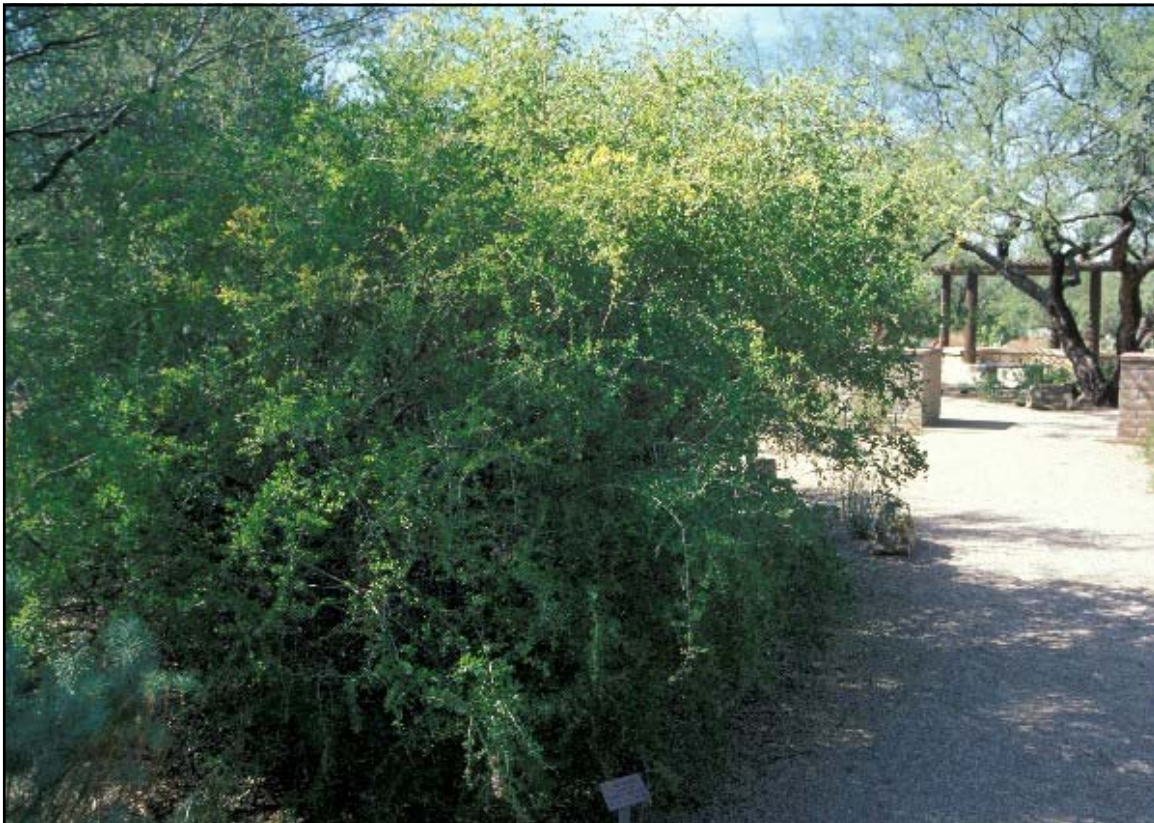




LYCIUM EXSERTUM THORNBUSH

Native to southwestern Arizona and Mexico, at elevations from 2000 to 4000 feet, this dense, spiny shrub provides excellent cover for birds and wildlife. The arching branches and light green leaves are covered with white hairs. Mature plants will be 8 feet in height and width. Small, white-purple flowers in the spring are followed by ¼ inch diameter red berries. Tough and durable, this shrub is tolerant of moderate cold, reflected heat, full sun, and drought. Hardy to 10° F. USDA Zone 7.
