



MAIREANA SEDIFOLIA BLUEBUSH

This Australian native is a rounded, evergreen shrub with striking small, silver-white, succulent leaves. It is related to our own native saltbushes and is quite tolerant of salinity. Inconspicuous brown to tan flowers are followed by flattened, straw-colored winged fruit. Excellent for use as a filler shrub or background plant in arid, alkaline soils, it should be planted in full sun or part shade and well-drained soils. The foliage is occasionally used for cut flower arrangements. Hardy to 25°F. USDA Zone 9.
