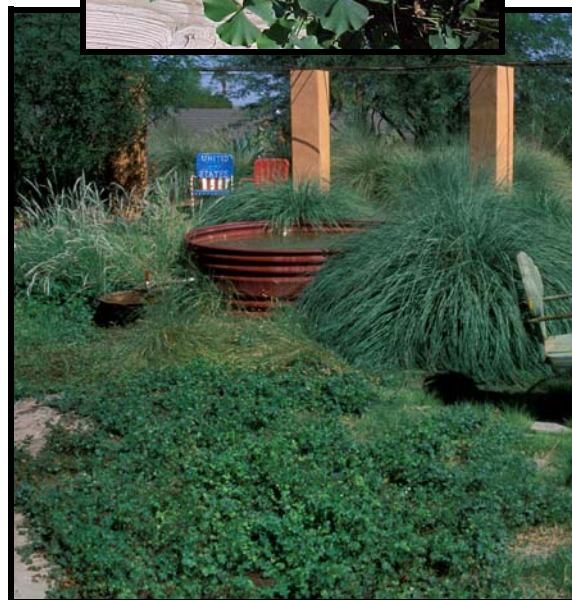




MARSILEA MACROPODA CLOVER FERN

Clover fern is excellent groundcover for shady locations, with lush, dark green clover-like leaves on long leaf stalks. Leaves on young plants have a downy like texture. Clover Fern grows to eight inches tall by two feet wide, spreading rapidly by rhizomes (underground stems). It is a great choice for planting between pavers. While this plant prefers shady locations, it can tolerate full sun if ample water is provided. Clover Fern performs well in moist soils and grows best with an overhead spray watering system in the low deserts. Clover Fern is evergreen except for a short period in winter. Shear back plants to keep the height in check and to encourage fresh, new growth. It is cold hardy to 0°F. USDA Zone 7.
