



## MAYTENUS PHYLLANTHOIDES MANGLE DULCE

This large evergreen shrub grows slowly to 12' tall by 15' wide. The leaves are leathery, spoon shaped, bright green and look somewhat like mistletoe. A few inconspicuous flowers are produced from April through November. It is quite tolerant of salty and brackish soils, and heavy poorly-drained sites. It is native to the coasts of Texas and Baja. Useful as a screen or hedge, it will grow in full sun to part shade. Hardy to 15°F. USDA Zone 8.
