



MERREMIA AUREA YELLOW MORNING GLORY VINE

This fast growing vine is native to the lower Sonoran Desert and Baja, California. The deep green, palmately compound leaves are evergreen in low desert areas. Bright yellow, 3-inch-diameter morning glory flowers are produced throughout the warm months. *Merremia* is quite drought tolerant and will grow rapidly with supplemental water, but good drainage is essential. Provide support such as a trellis or chain link fence for this vine. The underground tuber should provide a winter hardy plant surviving to about 15° F.
