



## NERIUM OLEANDER 'PETITE PINK'

Tough and durable, this dwarf evergreen shrub is widely used in the low deserts. The strap-like leaves are a deep, dark green. Clusters of bright pink, funnel-shaped flowers are formed during the summer on new growth. Every part of this plant is poisonous. Excellent for use as small hedges or borders, it will grow to a 4 by 4 foot size if left untrimmed. Oleanders may be planted in full sun or reflected heat. Hardy to 25° F it is placed in USDA Zone 9.
