



## PANICUM VIRGATUM 'DALLAS BLUES' P.P. 11202

Dallas Blues is an impressive ornamental grass originally collected in North Dallas. It has thin, bright blue leaves that are supposedly some of the bluest in the industry. It has an upright columnar habit creating a clump up to 5 feet in height and 5 feet across. It is tolerant of wet or dry soils, with the intensity of the foliage color increasing with drought. Pink to mauve fall flowers are held in interesting patterns above the foliage. The blue foliage transitions to tan or light brown in the winter. Root hardy to -30° F. USDA Zone 4.
