



PARKINSONIA MICROPHYLLA FOOTHILL PALO VERDE

Synonym: *Cercidium microphyllum*. Foothill palo verde is slightly smaller than the blue palo verde. The trees leaf out following seasonal rains, but tend to be leafless for most of the year. It also blooms after the blue palo verde, with masses of light yellow blossoms. This slow growing, thorny tree is very drought-tolerant, although supplemental watering during the dry season will speed up the growth rate. Foothill palo verde has a naturally shrubby, multi-trunked form. Hardy to 15° F. USDA Zone 8.
