



## PENSTEMON BACCHARIFOLIUS DEL RIO™ ROCK PENSTEMON

This shrub-like perennial forms a small clump of deep green foliage to 2 feet tall and wide, which looks good year 'round. In the spring and summer, short spikes of rose-red flowers are produced on the branch tips. The tubular flowers attract lots of hummingbirds. Rock penstemon requires extremely good drainage to perform well in the landscape. It prefers middle desert locations, where the summer temperatures are not as intense. Del Rio™ is a named clone that was selected near the Texas/Mexico border for its intense flower color.
