



PENSTEMON CARDINALIS CARDINAL PENSTEMON

Native to west Texas and the mountains of New Mexico, this perennial blooms with bright red flowers in early summer. Hummingbirds love it! The large fleshy blue-green leaves are heart shaped, and hug the stem closely. Plant in full sun and well-drained soils. Cardinal Penstemon will struggle in low desert regions, even if provided shade. It reseeds in the landscape. Hardy to -20° F. USDA Zone 5.
