



VETIVERIA ZIZANOIDES VETIVER GRASS

One of the most interesting features of this durable grass is the curly-Q's formed at the leaf tips. The narrow, bright green leaves bend about 4 inches from the tip, and eventually these tips brown and curl. Vetiver is a stately clump grass, growing to about 5 feet tall and wide. In the fall the leaves take on a bronzy-purple tint. It rarely blooms in our area. Cut back annually in the spring.
