



YUCCA SCHIDIGERA MOJAVE YUCCA

This Mojave Desert native is a slow-growing, trunk-forming species. The dull green leaves have curling fibers along the margins and sharp terminal spines. Dense clusters of white flowers tinged with purple are produced on spikes in the spring. This yucca is common at elevations below 2500 feet among the creosote bush chaparral. For best results, plant in full sun and excellent drainage. Hardy to 0° F. USDA Zone 7.
