



AGAVE BRACTEOSA GREEN SPIDER AGAVE

Perfect for patio containers or small planting spaces, Green Spider Agave rarely grows larger than one foot tall and wide. In hot low deserts it prefers some filtered shade. The flexible, spineless, lime green leaves twist and arch, providing a unique silhouette. Older specimens often generate new plants from rhizomes or the leaf axils, resulting in a wide-spreading mound of individual agaves. Native to the Mexican states of Coahuila and Nuevo Leon, it is hardy to 10° F. USDA Zone 7.
