



## AGAVE POTATORUM BUTTERFLY AGAVE

This beautiful, petite agave tops out at about 1 to 2 feet tall by 2 feet wide. The striking blue-gray leaves terminate in a distinctive, often twisted, reddish spine. The leaf margins display pronounced swellings at the base of the teeth, resulting in a ruffly appearance. Although considered tender below 25° F, Butterfly Agave is ideal for use in low desert locations. *Agave potatorum* is native to the Mexican states of Puebla and Oaxaca at elevations from 4500 to 7500 feet.
