



CAREX TUMULICOLA BERKELEY SEDGE

Berkeley Sedge ranges from the state of Washington to central California, occurring in arid areas. The foliage is dark green, forming arching clumps to 18 inches tall and wide. The small brown flowers are not showy, but provide some textural interest, dancing above the foliage on tall stems. Berkeley Sedge spreads slowly from rhizomes. While we prefer it in an unmowed, natural form, it is said to be a great lawn substitute. The evergreen foliage is hardy to about 15°F. USDA Zone 8
