



# CHILOPSIS LINEARIS WARREN JONES™ DESERT WILLOW

This clone of desert willow was named in honor of the famed Landscape Architecture Professor Emeritus Warren Jones, of the University of Arizona. This willow grows quickly to about 25 to 30 feet tall and wide. It was selected for its large, showy, light pink flowers. Producing fewer seedpods than usual, this introduction is an excellent choice for patios and along paths or walkways. In low deserts Warren Jones™ is nearly evergreen, or is deciduous for a very short period of time. Hardy to about 0°F. USDA Zone 6.
