



CONOCLINIUM (EUPATORIUM) GREGGII BOOTHILL™

During the warm season this perennial is covered with clusters of flowers that are magnets for butterflies. Boothill™ has fine-textured, light green foliage and fuzzy lavender flowers reminiscent of *Ageratum* species. The foliage may burn back in the winter, but recovers quickly from underground stems. Frost-damaged foliage should be pruned back in the early spring. Periodic pruning throughout the year will help maintain a denser form. Boothill™ is a wonderful perennial to incorporate into oasis zones close to buildings, where its charms can be easily enjoyed. It requires more water than many plants we grow, and prefers light filtered shade in the low deserts.
