

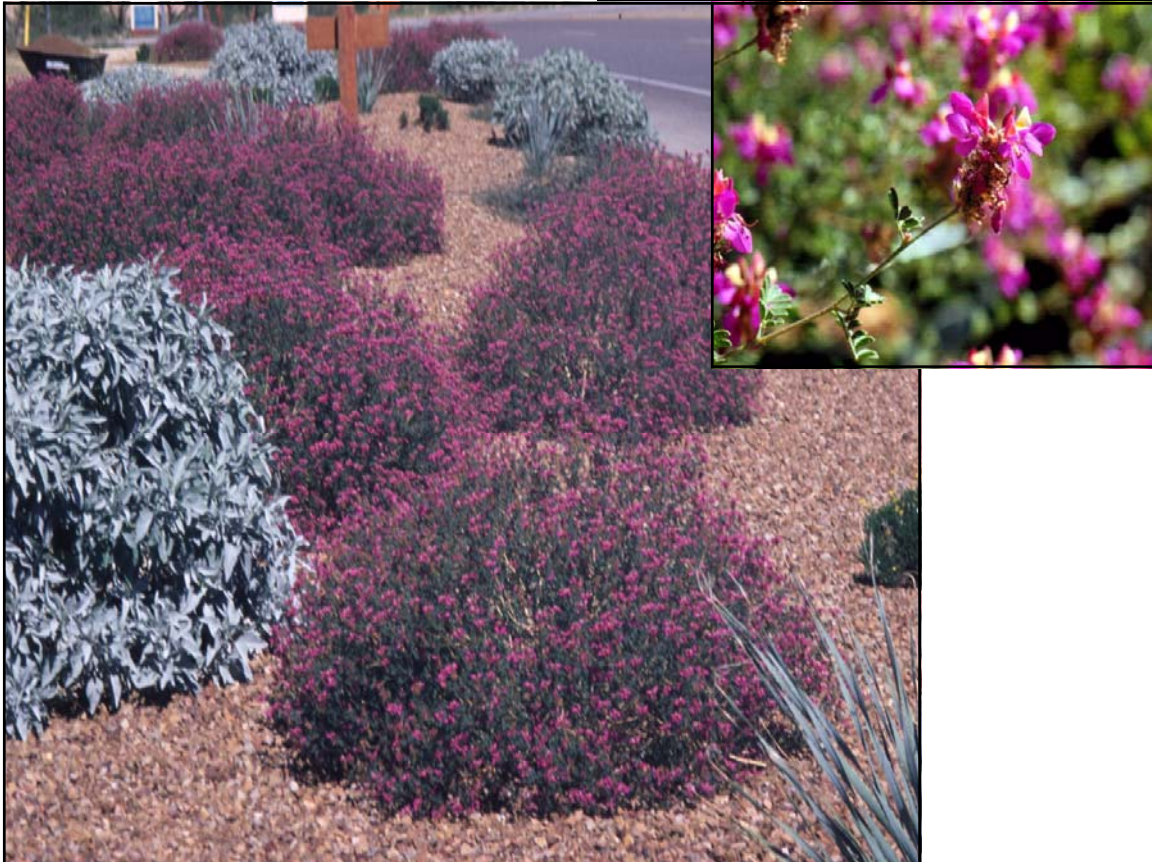


DALEA FRUTESCENS SIERRA NEGRA™ BLACK DALEA

Because it is a rare fall bloomer, black dalea is an indispensable ingredient for desert landscapes. In the late fall, it is covered with masses of intense purple flowers that provide a striking contrast for our many yellow-flowering plants. Evergreen in the low deserts, this shrub forms a rounded mound of fine-textured grey-green foliage. Plant Sierra Negra™ in full sun, well-drained soil, and be careful not to over-water. Bees will converge on this shrub during the bloom season.
