



NOLINA LINDHEIMERIANA SACAHUISTA

Native to the Edwards Plateau of Texas, this accent plant forms a clump of grass-like leathery leaves. It is very similar in appearance to *Nolina texana*, slowly growing to a 2 to 3 foot height and width. The narrow, green leaves have small teeth along the margins. Creamy white flower spikes are held above the foliage. Plant in full sun and well-drained soil. Hardy to -20° F it is placed in USDA Zone 5.
