



## NOLINA MICROCARPA BEAR GRASS

For textural interest and sheer ease of maintenance, it is hard to find a better plant than Bear Grass. This clean, accent plant is a great choice for planting around water features. Native to the Southwest, this grass like plant forms a clump to three feet tall by four feet wide. The long, slender leaves are glossy-green, with finely toothed margins. The leaf tips fray to form highly ornamental white curls. In the summer it sends up a tall stalk of greenish flowers. Bear Grass is adapted to -10° F, USDA Zone 5 and tolerates full sun or part shade exposures and requires well-drained soil.
