



PARTHENOCISSUS SP. HACIENDA CREEPER™

Hacienda Creeper™ resembles Virginia Creeper, but is much smaller and slower-growing. This self-climbing, deciduous vine has bright green palmate leaves. With adequate fall chilling, the foliage will turn a deep red color. It forms a dense screen when grown on a chain link fence, and is also suitable for use as a groundcover or espalier. It is adapted to full sun or part shade, poor soils and some drought. In low deserts such as Phoenix some light shade is preferred. Hardy to 0°F. USDA Zone 6.
