



PENSTEMON BACCHARIFOLIUS DIABLO™ ROCK PENSTEMON

This shrubby perennial forms small clumps of dark green, succulent foliage. Vibrant rose-red flowers are produced in short spikes on the branch tips in spring and summer. Diablo™ will bloom intermittently through the spring and summer months and is much more colorful than other species. Rock Penstemon requires extremely well-drained soils to perform well in the landscape. It also prefers a little afternoon shade in the summer. This Texas native is plenty hardy at 0° F.
