



PSILOSTROPHE COOPERI PAPER FLOWER

This perennial is native to Arizona, California, New Mexico and into Mexico at elevations from 2000 to 5000 feet. It has needlelike light green leaves produced on rounded mounds about 2 feet in diameter. In the spring and summer masses of small yellow flowers are produced. The flowers dry to a papery tan color and persist for a long time. Plant in full sun and extremely well-drained soils. Hardy to 10° F. USDA Zone 7.
