



## YUCCA DECIPIENS PALMA CHINA

This slow-growing yucca is native to central Mexico, at elevations ranging from 6000 to 8000 feet. It is reminiscent of the Joshua Tree, eventually forming a branched treelike form. The green leaves are stiff, sharp, and edged with white threads; growing to 2 inches wide by 2 feet long. Our seed-grown specimens in 20 gallon containers are about 10 years old. Plant Palma China in full sun and well-drained soils. It is hardy to at least 6°F.
