

Plants for a Sensory Garden

***Acacia smallii*...Sweet acacia**

Has very fragrant yellow puff-ball flowers in the spring. (Note: this tree does have thorns, so it would need to be lifted over head level)

***Abutilon palmeri*...Indian mallow**

This shrub has velvety-soft, touchable leaves.

***Aloysia triphylla*...Lemon verbena**

The leaves of this shrub smell and taste like lemons.

Artemisia species

A group of sages with aromatic foliage.

***Bebbia juncea*...Sweet bush**

A rather scraggly looking shrub with intensely fragrant flowers.

***Berlandiera lyrata*...Chocolate flower**

The yellow daisy-like flowers of this small perennial have the heady fragrance of chocolate.

***Chamaebatiaria millefolium*...Fernbush**

This high-elevation shrub hits the jackpot with fragrant flowers and foliage!

***Chrysactinia mexicana*...Damianita**

This small shrub has very aromatic foliage.

***Coursetia glandulosa*...Baby bonnets**

Large shrub with tiny, fragrant, pea-shaped flowers.

***Dalea capitata Sierra Gold*TM**

This ground cover has foliage with a delicate lemony scent.

***Eysenhardtia orthocarpa*...Kidneywood**

Small, airy tree with delicate spikes of fragrant white flowers.

***Hyptis emoryi*...Desert lavender**

A large, narrow shrub with a pungent fragrance.

***Larrea tridentata*...Creosote**


What a heavenly fragrance after summer rains!

***Leucophyllum laevigatum*...Chihuahuan sage**

The flowers of this shrub provide a delicate scent in the late summer and early fall.

***Leucophyllum pruinatum* Sierra BouquetTM**

This shrub blooms in the summer and fall with flowers that smell like grape bubble gum.



If you plant *Lavender Spice*[™]
in your garden you may enjoy the
fragrance and taste of oregano.



Oenothera caespitosa, White Evening Primrose

***Muhlenbergia capillaris* Regal Mist[™]**
The narrow leaves of this ornamental
grass are slick and waxy. It also has
plumes of soft, misty flowers in the fall
months.

***Oenothera caespitosa*...White evening
primrose**
Huge white flowers have a delicate
fragrance.

***Osmanthus fragrans*...Sweet olive**
The tiny flowers on this shrub have an
incredibly sweet fragrance! We do not
grow it, but call Baker's Nursery in
Phoenix.

***Penstemon palmeri*...Scented penstemon**
This high-elevation penstemon has large,
light pink, fragrant blossoms.

***Poliomintha maderensis* Lavender Spice[™]**
Small shrub with the fragrance and taste
of oregano.

***Prunus besseyi*...Western sand cherry**
This large, deciduous shrub for high-
elevation gardens produces sprays of
fragrant white flowers in the spring.

***Sophora secundiflora*...Texas mountain laurel**
This large shrub/small tree has clusters
of purple flowers that smell like grape
bubble gum.

***Salvia leucantha*...Mexican bush sage**
This shrub blooms in the fall and spring
with velvety-soft purple flower spikes.

***Salvia clevelandii*...Chaparral sage**
This large shrub has very aromatic
foliage.

***Stipa tenuissima* (*Nassella tenuissima*)
...Mexican feather grass, threadgrass**
Irresistably touchable, petite
ornamental grass.

***Tagetes lemmonii*...Mount Lemmon marigold**
This shrub has extremely aromatic
foliage.

***Tagetes lucida*...Licorice marigold**
The foliage of this shrub smells and
tastes like licorice.

***Zephyranthes candida*...Rain lily**
The narrow leaves of this small plant
are slick & shiny.
